Medical

Sterilised disposable delivery kits (over 500) have been distributed in rural & Adivasi areas for clean sterile delivery where hospitals are not available.



Sports Day for hearing impaired children

In view of misuse of disposable needles & syringes in hospitals which can spread extremely contagious virus of HIV AIDS & other infections, we have donated 18 needle crushing devices in several hospitals in their children and pathological wards, including Sion, Nanavati, Homeopathic college

Conducted laparoscopic surgery at Vasai in three medical camps for the local women with the assistance of Dr. P. V. Mehta., in an ongoing Family planning programme.

Donated six water purifiers in five hospitals including Nanavati, Homeopathy, Arogyanidhi and V. N. Desai hospitals. Also sponsored construction of tiles taps etc in the O.P.D. of Homeopathy hospital.

Community & Club Service.

Donated sewing machines to a deserving lady and to inmates of Thane jail.

Contributed Rs. 5000 to toilet blocks at CST station for street children.

Celebrated 50 years of Indian Independence by inviting and honouring the mothers and mothers-in-law of members to a programme of bhajans and patriotic songs, conducted an essay competition in four languages, on 'Kuch Yaadien; Fifty Years ago.' 



REPORTED IN HW NEWSLETTER


