ORANGE CHEESE CAKE INGREDIENTS:

8 tablespoons crushed Marie biscuits.

6 tablespoons melted butter.

25 grams powdered Sugar.

1 Packet (100 gms) Orange Jelly.

1 1/2 litre Vanilla ice-cream.

2 tablespoons fresh curd.

2 tablespoons powdered sugar. Juice of ½ Lemon.

METHOD:

Mix butter, biscuits & sugar and press into a 8" or 9" diameter dish. Chill until firm. Dissolve the Jelly in 2 teacups of boiling water. Pour the boiling Jelly liquid over the ice cream. Beat well. Add the sugar, curds and lemon juice. Place on ice and stir for 10 minutes. When a little thick, pour over the crust. Put to set in the refrigerator. When set decorate with fresh cream and orange slices.

CHEESY GOLDEN FINGERS

INGREDIENTS:

7 to 8 Slices of Bread

1 grated Carrot

1 finely chopped Cucumber

2 tbs. Soft Butter

1 tbs. Fresh Cream

5 tbs. Grated Cheese

1 chopped Green Chilli

1 tsp. Mustard Powder

METHOD:

Toast the Bread Slices, mix butter, mustard and 3 tbs. of cheese until very soft. Add carrot, cucumber, green chilli, cream and salt. Spread this mixture over the toast. Sprinkle the remaining Cheese over the toast. Grill or Bake in a hot oven at 450° F for 15 mts.

- 4. World Deaf Day was celebrated by holding an Exhibition and Sale of articles made at Institutions for the Mentally and Physically Handicapped. There was also an Entertainment Programme by the children from these special Schools, the entire Programme was sponsored by the Club.

In view of the misuse of disposable needles and syringes in hospitals which can spread the extremely contagious virus of AIDS and other infections, we have taken up an ongoing Programme of meeting the needs of two Municipal hospitals i.e. Sion hospital & Cooper hospital. We have donated six needle-crushing machines in these hospitals sponsored by our Members.
- Conducted Laparoscopic Surgery at Vasai in a Medical Camp for the local woman with the assistance of Dr. P. V. Mehta in an ongoing Family Planning Programme.

SR.CITIZENS:

 We celebrated the 50th Year of India's Independence by inviting and honoring Mothers and Mothers-in-law of Innerwheel Members who were requested to write about their experiences 50 years ago. Prizes were given for best entries. On this occasion we had invited veteran freedom fighters including Maniben Nanavati and Mrinal Gore who shared their memories following a programme of Bhajans and Patriotic Songs.
